➔ In 2015, business organizations, religious communities, and community members who had a concern for the plight of the homeless worked in collaboration with the City of Citrus Heights and Sacramento Self-Help Housing to begin a program assisting the homeless in Citrus Heights. This group is the Citrus Heights Homeless Assistance Resource Team (HART).

Winter Shelter

This past 2016-17 winter season, we provided a warm shelter for 20-30 homeless individuals every night for a period of 7 weeks.

This has been a wonderful opportunity to become involved and help alleviate the suffering of the homeless during the coldest, wettest weeks of winter. The winter shelter is a wonderful opportunity to participate in our greater community and host a safe and welcoming place for those that don't have a home.

Veterans Stand Down

Citrus Heights HART's annual Veterans Stand Down is host to more than thirty vendors, each of whom provide goods or services to veterans and their families at no cost. Attendees are offered breakfast, lunch, and snacks in addition to clothing and personal care items. They are also encouraged to take advantage of services such as housing assistance, employment counseling, dental services, haircuts, veterinary services, and more.

Citrus Heights Navigator

Since 2016, Citrus Heights has their own Navigator that identifies and helps homeless individuals in our city. The Navigator works with the Citrus Heights Police Department, Sacramento Self-Help Housing, and Citrus Heights HART to efficiently locate and provide housing resources for those in need.
