SacRT is offering FREE shuttle rides from the Historic Folsom and Glenn/Robert G. Holderness light rail stations to Rodeo Park in Folsom on Friday, July 1 through Sunday, July 3. Skip the parking and let SacRT do the driving! Rodeo event attendees can ride free on SacRT light rail and Folsom shuttle buses to the Rodeo. To ride free, simply show your valid Folsom Pro Rodeo admission ticket to the bus operator upon boarding or have ready for the fare inspector while riding light rail.

The free shuttle will operate every 30 minutes between light rail stations and Rodeo Park all three days. The first shuttle will depart at 4 p.m. from the Historic Folsom Station arriving Rodeo Park at 4:15 p.m. The last shuttle will depart Rodeo Park at 10:15 p.m. and arrive at the Historic Folsom Station at 10:20 p.m. In the past parking is available at Theodore Judah School and there is a shuttle. Parking on Stafford St. is also available.



Big Day of Giving Results

Funds go to support our Bidwell Studios program, providing opportunities for members of the unhoused community to stand up on their own two feet. Every donation makes a difference, enriching the experience for our recipients, who work with mentors that guide them through the process of achieving greater independence and self-confidence.

The BDOG is organized by the Sacramento Region Community Foundation to promote the work of nonprofits throughout Northern California. The support HART of Folsom received from our donors puts us in the top 100 organizations (out of 762!) participating in the Sacramento area. Over 31,000 donors gave a record \$31.8M as part of this year's entire BDOG efforts. We are proud to be a part of this consortium of nonprofits all doing great work to make our

region stronger and to lift those in need of support.

The link below is for the local homeless action plan created as a cross-jurisdictional unified approach to addressing homelessness across Sacramento County. It is a three-year plan beginning on July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2025. It is actionable, relatable, and provides a roadmap for future funding.

Outlined in the plan are key system components that are in alignment with national best-practices and if resourced and implemented consistently across funders and providers, will bring the local response system to scale with capacity to move the needle on homelessness.
