The HART of Folsom Winter Shelter runs nightly through March 3 with Intake at 5:00 pm at Upper Rodeo gate area off Stafford Street. We are very grateful for all the faithful volunteers and host groups who serve our unhoused adults in Folsom. We'd also like to thank all the restaurants, businesses and donors who provide support.

We always have a warm and safe overnight place for unhoused adults to rest. And most weeks we also have showers and laundry. It's a wonderful thing to hear during dinner, the expressions of gratitude for good food and a great place to be, from our guests,

Thank you to Powerhouse Ministry, Jake's Journey Home and our own Transitional Housing program for helping our guests connect to services. Our goal is to have as many of our guests as possible find help and hope for change, as they relax and rest overnight. We have had 400 bed-nights thus far in the season. We're averaging 11 guests per night and all is well at the shelter!
