Monthly Volunteer Highlight

Holly Davatz

Holly first learned about HART through Judi Alexander. They were meeting for Happy Hour before Christmas, and Judi was asked how things were going with HART. Holly learned that HART ran a Winter Shelter for the unhoused in Folsom, providing a warm, dry place to rest at night during the coldest nights of the year. As Judi spoke about HART, she was moved. Judi was passionate about the work that was happening through HART and shared that the winter shelter Sunday Morning Storage Pod was still available. Holly thought about it for a few seconds, and before she could stop herself she said, "I can do that." This past Winter was her fourth year volunteering for HART.

She said, "Volunteering for HART allows me to be a part of something, profoundly meaningful, that is much bigger than myself. The Winter Shelter runs smoothly because of an intricately woven synergy of lots of volunteers, each performing one job, usually one night a week. Alone, each job seems small, but the shelter couldn't run without each person showing up. Everyone is there for each other with the intent to offer care and compassion to those in need."

Holly is grateful for the opportunity to build community with such caring volunteers and to serve those that may feel unseen and forgotten. For those that are thinking about volunteering, Holly says, "Look over the volunteer jobs, pick a small job if you feel a little nervous, then say, "I can do that." "With the support of all the other volunteers, it's doable...and it matters so much to our guests."
